

## **Lesson 2 Student Guide – *The Assurance of Salvation***

**Lesson goal:** The goal of this class is to assure students of their salvation as a gift from God and answer the question “Must I choose to have faith?”

**Pre-Lesson Preparation:** Read Ephesians 2:1-10.

### **Think**

13. Spiritually, how are we born into this world?
14. Because of the way we are born, what are we incapable of doing?

15. What is the opinion of the legalist pastor in regard to our ability to choose Jesus?

16. If I can't choose Jesus, how do I know that I have faith?
