11. What does God teach you to do in this lesson?

Lead

12. What would be a good situation in which to share this message?

Additional questions

13. Reflect on the story in Titus 3:1-7. What were we like before God converted us? How did God intervene on our behalf? What is the Holy Spirit's role in our salvation?
14. Read 1 Timothy 2:4. What is God's will for all human beings?
15. What does sanctification mean?
16. Read Romans 8:7; Ephesians 2:1; and 2 Corinthians 4:4. Why can't we convert ourselves?

Lesson wrap-up

17. What is the Holy Spirit's role in our salvation? How does he sanctify us?

18. Why can't we convert ourselves or make a decision to follow Christ?
