

Lesson 2 Student Guide - *Jesus Feeds the Five Thousand*

Lesson Goal: The goal of this class is to answer this question: “How are the miracles in this lesson important to believers?”

Pre-Lesson Preparation: Read Matthew 14:13-33.

Think: Get the class thinking about an interesting topic or question.

Evaluate: Bring more meaning and context to the lesson.

7. What is the problem?
8. What happened in the story?
9. Was the problem solved?

Learn: Identify that sin is the problem and only God has the answer.

10. What is the main theme of the lesson?
11. What sin does this lesson teach you to confess?
12. Where do you see the love of God in the lesson?
13. What does God teach you to do in the lesson?

Lead: Share this with a group of your brothers and sisters in Christ.

14. What would be a good situation in which to share this message?

16. How does the Bible lead us to accept that miracles are possible?
