

Lesson 6 Student Guide - Jesus Is Crucified

Lesson Goal: The goal of this class is to answer these questions: “What happened at the crucifixion of Jesus? How was Jesus’ suffering part of God’s plan for us?”

Before class: Read Luke 23:13-34.

Think - Get your audience to think about an interesting topic or question.

1. Of what did the chief priests finally decide to convict Jesus?
2. How do we compare to the criminal Barabbas?

Evaluate - Bring more meaning and context to the lesson.

3. Who are the characters in this story?
4. What are the objects in this story?
5. Where did this story happen?
6. When did this story happen?
7. What is the problem?
8. What events occurred in this story?
9. Is the problem solved?

Learn - Identify that sin is the problem and only God has the answer.

10. What is the main theme of this lesson?
11. What sin does this lesson teach us to confess?
12. Where do you see the love of God in this lesson?
13. What does God teach us to do in this lesson?

Lead - Share this with a group of your brothers and sisters in Christ.

14. What would be a good situation in which to share this message?

Additional questions: add depth to the lesson.

15. Why did Pilate ultimately grant the demands of the people and surrender Jesus to be crucified?

16. What does Jesus mean when he quotes Hosea 10:8 as he is passing by the women who are weeping and wailing?

17. How was Jesus' suffering part of God's plan for us?
