- 9. Is the problem solved?

Learn: Identify that sin is the problem and only God has the answer.

- 10. What is the main theme of this lesson?
- 11. What sin does this lesson teach us to confess?
- 12. Where do you see the love of God in this lesson?
- 13. What does God teach us to do in this lesson?

Lead: Share this with a group of your brothers and sisters in Christ.

14. What would be a good situation in which to share this message?

Additional questions: add depth to the lesson.

- 15. Read John 13:1-16. Why did Jesus wash his disciples' feet before the Passover supper?
- 16. What "communion" happens when we receive this sacrament?
