Learn - Identify that sin is the problem and only God has the answer.

- 10. What is the main theme of this lesson?
- 11. What sin does this lesson teach us to confess?
- 12. Where do you see the love of God in this lesson?
- 13. What does God teach us to do in this lesson?
- Lead Share this with a group of your brothers and sisters in Christ.
 - 14. What would be a good situation in which to share this message?

Additional questions: add depth to the lesson.

15. What other miraculous events occurred while Jesus was dying on the cross?

16. What did the process of crucifixion include?
