Lesson 9 Student Guide - The Promise of a Cross on Earth and Treasure in Heaven

Lesson goal: The goal of this class is to encourage students to recognize that God does not promise material wealth on Earth but that he promises a cross on Earth and eternal blessings in Heaven.

Pre-Lesson Preparation: Read Luke 16:19-31.

Additional questions

13. What is the "Prosperity Gospel" and what passage is used as a Biblical support for this teaching? (Read James 4:2).

- 14. What does the context around this passage teach us?
- 15. One of the requirements of the prosperity gospel is that the person who is asking must be living a righteous life. To what graphic image does the Bible (Isaiah 64:6) compare our "righteous acts"?
- 16. Jesus did not preach a gospel of prosperity. Read Mark 8:34 and 1 Peter4: 12-16. What did Jesus tell us about earthly blessings in these passages?
- 17. Read Colossians 3:1-3 and Revelation 2:10. Where do theses passages tell us to focus our attention?
- 18. Are there earthly blessings to living a Christian life? (Read 2 Corinthians 9:6, Philippians 4:19, and Matthew 6)?
